Your Privacy

At DO Theatre Productions, we're committed to maintaining the trust and confidence of our members, employees and audiences. In this Privacy Policy, you'll find detailed information on when and why we collect personal information, how we use it, the limited conditions under which we may disclose it to others and how we keep it secure. We admit this isn't the most exciting of things, but it is important, so please do read on anyway.

Collection and Use of Personal Information

Personal information means any information that may be used to identify you, such as, your name, title, phone number, theatre credits, email address, or portfolio. In general, you can browse our web site without providing any personal information to us, but if you want to be a member, in our audience, or set up a profile, submitting your data will be necessary.

We use that information for several reasons: to tell you about things you've asked us to keep you informed of; to contact you if we need to obtain or provide additional information; to check our records are right; and – if you're a member – to keep you in touch with rehearsal and production decisions.

We use several products to analyse traffic to our web site in order to understand our visitors' needs and to continually improve our site for them. We collect only anonymous, aggregate statistics.

Children and Privacy

If you're aged 13 or under, you need to get permission from your parents or guardian to register your information either on our site, or as part of an audience or membership form.

Use of Cookies

A cookie is a small text file containing information that a web site transfers to your computer's hard disk for record-keeping purposes and allows us to analyse our site traffic patterns. They're neither chocolatey nor edible, and for that we can only apologise. A cookie cannot give us access to your computer or to information beyond what you provide us. Most web browsers automatically accept

cookies; consult your browser's manual or online help if you want information on restricting or disabling the browser's handling of cookies. If you disable cookies, you can still view the publicly available information on our web site. If you are using a shared computer and you have cookies turned on, be sure to log off when you finish.
